

Showcase


Why is light so important?


























Christmas Hats, Lunch and Jumper Days!

Thank you for supporting our school kitchen for Christmas lunch this year – we had a record number of children who enjoyed their roast lunch and chocolate cake – pretty much every child!


We also collected £115 for Save the Children on Christmas Jumper Day last Friday.


Christingle Celebration

A big well done to all the children who received Head Teacher's Certificates this term!






















Severe Weather Procedures

Wherever possible Oakhill School will remain open. It may, however, be necessary for the school to close in the case of extreme weather conditions or there being insufficient adult supervision.

If the decision is made not to open the school because of deteriorating conditions overnight, a message will be posted on the school website homepage and a notice will be put up outside school as early as possible to tell you that the school is closed.

If possible, the school telephone will be staffed from 8.30-10.00am so that enquiries can be made and again from 3.00-4.30pm. Occasionally this may not be possible if members of staff are unable to get to the school.

If worsening weather conditions indicate that by 3.15pm children and staff may have difficulty getting home, every attempt will be made to contact you to ask you to come and collect your children from school.

If you anticipate difficulties collecting your children later in the day due to weather conditions, please come early and collect children from school or telephone to let us know what arrangements to make. The Head Teacher or other authorised person will remain at school until all children have been safely collected.
